

**Propeller Club of the United States Port of Norfolk  
Old Dominion University Student Propeller Club Scholarship**

The Propeller Club of the United States Port of Norfolk hereby institutes an annual scholarship of \$2,500 to be awarded to a member of the Old Dominion University Student Propeller Club who is enrolled in a degree program with a concentration in Maritime, Ports and Logistics Management.

Candidates for the scholarship must comply with the following requirements:

- 1) Be an active member of the Student Propeller Club for at least one semester.
- 2) Be a full time student enrolled in a degree program with a concentration in Maritime, Ports and Logistics Management and meeting the following requirements:
  - a) Graduate degree candidates must have accumulated at least one-half of the credit hours required to satisfy degree requirements.
  - b) Undergraduate degree candidates must have accumulated at least three-fourths of the credit hours required to satisfy degree requirements.
  - c) Have a minimum cumulative Grade Point Average of 3.0
- 3) Be recommended by both the Director of the Maritime Institute and the President of the Student Propeller Club
- 4) Agree to provide approximately 120 hours (60 hours per semester at the rate of approximately 4 hours per week) of assistance to the Propeller Club of the United States Port of Norfolk.

The Scholarship funds will be directed to Old Dominion University for deposit to student's account.

Scholarship applications will be due on April 1 of each year. The Board of Governors of the Propeller Club of the United States Port of Norfolk will evaluate the applications and will announce the winner at the June meeting. The Scholarship money will be forwarded to Old Dominion University no later than June 30 of each year.
